

ANNEXURE**(GUIDELINES FOR ENGAGING THE SERVICES OF MEDICAL OFFICER, LAB TECHNICIAN, PHARMACIST AND ANM/MPHA (F) ON CONTRACT / OUTSOURCING BASIS)**

Online applications are invited from the eligible candidates for engaging the services of Medical Officer, Lab Technician, Pharmacist and ANM/MPHA (F) to work under the administrative control of the DPH&FW & CH&FW, on Contract/ Outsourcing basis, in Nalgonda District for a period up to 31.03.2022, or till the actual need ceases, whichever is earlier.

AGE:

The minimum age is 18 years and maximum age is 34 years and shall be reckoned as on 01-07-2021 with the following relaxations allowed for reckoning the maximum age limit as per rules:

- i) For SCs, STs & BCs 5 (Five) years
- ii) For ex-servicemen 3 (three) years in addition to the length of service in armed forces.
- iii) Disabled persons 10 (ten) years
