EDUCATIONAL & OTHER QUALIFICATIONS:

(a) Essential:

A BDS Degree of an Indian University or an equivalent qualification with Post Graduate qualification / Diplomate of National Board in the subject and as amended by DCI from time to time.



- Age:- Upper Age limit is **40** years as on **19/06/2023**. Relaxable by 5(five) years in case of SC,ST,PH/PWD candidates and Government servants candidates and as amended by DCI from time to time for the above categories. However, the SC/ST/Govt. Servant will not get the further relaxation of 5(five) years over and above relaxation of 5(five) years which they are already entitled to get as SC/ST candidates.
- * In pursuance of GA(P&T) Department memo No. F.23 (11)/-GA(P&T)/2022 dated 11.07.2022 2(two) years age relaxation in upper age limit for all categories of candidates for direct recruitment in Govt. departments & PSUs. due to Covid pandemic .

The last date of submission of online application is 19.06.2023 (upto 5.30 PM). The application (s) received after the closing date will not be entertained.

* Selection procedure; The selection procedure will be governed as per "Annexure-A "(scheduled-VI) of the notified scheduled of the post of Assistant Professor.

Other Important information:-

1. Online Application Portal:

- (a) Candidates will have to submit application through Online Application Portal only. The Commission will not entertain any hard copy application. Before submission of online application, read carefully the instruction to candidates.
- (b) Online Application Portal will be available on Commission's website from 05/06/2023 to 19/06/2023 (5.30 PM). Before applying for the post, an applicant shall register his/her bio- data particulars through One Time Profile Registration (OTPR) on the Commission's Website viz. tpsc.tripura.gov.in. Once applicant registers his/her particulars, a User ID is generated and sent to his/her registered mobile number and email ID. Applicants need to apply for the post using the OTPR User ID through the Commission's website.
- (c) Applicants should avoid submitting multiple applications. However, if due to any unavoidable circumstances, any applicant submits multiple applications then he/she must ensure that the application with latest Receipt Number is complete in all respect.
- (d) In case of multiple applications, the application with latest Receipt Number shall only be entertained by the Commission and fee paid against one Receive Number shall not be adjusted against any other Receipt Number.
- 2. (a) Candidates are required to submit self attested copy of certificates in support of their claims regarding Age, Educational Qualifications Madhyamik on words (all marksheet and certificates), Attempt Certificate of BDS, PG (MDS/DNB), Registration Certificate from the appropriate authority, Permanent Resident Certificate/Citizenship Certificate, Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes, Experience Certificates, API score (as per Scheduled -VI) and others, if any. The application form along with documents will have to be submitted in the receipt section or by post addressed to the Secretary TPSC, Agartala, PIN-799001. Submission of such documents including through post will be allowed up to 23.06.2023 (5.30 PM) along with printed copy of Online application form failing which candidature will be treated as cancelled. The Commission will not entertain any application thereafter.

- b) Applicants must be in possession of the prescribed minimum qualification(s). Mere issue of admission certificate to the candidate will not imply that his/her candidature has been finally cleared by the Commission. On scrutiny of documents, if a candidate found ineligible as per terms & condition of the Advertisement (including prescribed Recruitment fee) his /her candidature will be rejected.
- **3.** (a)Recruitment fee for Group-A Posts:- Rs.400/- (Rupees Four Hundred) only for General Candidates and Rs. 350/-(Rupees three Hundred and Fifty) only for ST/SC/BPL card holders/Physically Handicapped Candidates. Recruitment fee is non-refundable.
 - (b) SC/ST Candidates of other States are not recognized by the Govt. of Tripura.
- (c) If a candidate submits incomplete application in respect of terms & condition of the Advertisement and without requisite recruitment fee, his/her candidature will be rejected.
- 4. SC/ST Candidates of other States (not recognized by the Govt. of Tripura) should apply for unreserved vacancy as general candidate along with recruitment fee prescribed for general candidates.
- **5.** If the application is not routed through proper channel, at the day of interview candidates will have to submit 'no objection' certificate failing which his/ her candidature will not be considered for preparation of final merit list. In that no-objection certificate, it is to be clearly mentioned that your employer has **'No-objection'** if you are considered for recruitment to the post for which you have applied for.
- **6.** Decision of the Commission regarding eligibility or otherwise of a candidate at any stage of the selection process shall be final.
- **7.** Candidates are instructed to visit the Commission's website for information regarding steps of recruitment process time to time.
- 8. Mobile Phone/Electronic Gadgets etc. are banned in the Campus of the Examination Premises /Interview Premises. Any Phone/ Electronic Gadget found in possession of any candidate in the Examination Premises /Interview Premises shall be confiscated forthwith and he/she may be debarred from appearing at the Examination /interview and also for the Examination(s)/Interview to be conducted by the Commission in future Violation of such instruction will be dealt as per Law.
- **9.** Entry in the Examination hall/ Interview Premises with Jacket, Coat, Pull over & this type of garments will not be allowed .

1. BDS Degree: Total Score - 10 marks

- i) 1st Professional Examination 2.5 marks (Passed in First attempt)
- ii) 2nd Professional Examination -2. 5 marks (Passed in First attempt)
- iii) 3rd Professional Examination 2.5 marks (Passed in First attempt)
- iv) 4th Professional Examination 2.5 marks (Passed in First attempt)
- v) Full marks will be awarded who passed all professional exams in 1st (first) attempt
- vi) ½ (half) marks will be deducted from each professional exam for each additional attempt (more than one) to pass the professional examination (From total marks of 10).
- vii) 5 or more additional attempt to pass the professional examination will invite zero (0) marking the obtained marks of a candidate from the concerned professional exam (From total marks of 10).

2. PG (MDS/DNB) Degree: Total Score- 20 marks

- I. Full marks will be awarded who passed his/her Post Graduate examination (MDS/DNB equated to MDS) in 1" (first) attempt (Total marks 20).
- II. 2(two) marks will be deducted for each additional attempt (more than one) to pass the Post Graduate professional examination (From total marks of 20).

3. Publications: Total Score- 10 marks

- i) Research publication/ case report in international journal @ 5 marks/ publication and national journal @ 2.5 marks/ publication with a maximum of 10 marks
- i) Publication must comprise with the latest DCI approved indexed Journal.
- iii) No marks will be added for Non Index Journal or publication not comprising with latest DCI guideline for publication of Journal.
- iv) Research paper/Case Report must be published during PG Study period & post PG period.
- v) Candidate must be first, second or Correspondence Author of the publications, otherwise the marks of publications will not be added.
- 4. Gold medal in any of the Dental Qualification (BDS/MDS in overall mark and not in a particular subject) 10
- 5. **Interview 50** (Number of candidates will be called in the interview as per prevailing TPSC norms)

Total Score= 10+20 +10 + 10+ 50 = 100
